RECOMMENDED PROCESS

- All consumers to be notified of water situation and watering of gardens restricted to 2 days per week for 2 hours only.
- All consumers to be notified that the use of hose pipes is prohibited and if found using hose pipe a fine
 of R500.00 to be implemented and the hose pipe confiscated. (These measures to be implemented
 before the use of pumped water is necessary).
- As soon as it becomes necessary to pump water from elsewhere, all consumers to be notified of the increase in tariffs. i.e. 0-6kl free > 7kl = R11.53 p/kl.
- 4. (2) and (3) to remain in force for as long as it is necessary to pump water from elsewhere.
- 5. (1) and/or (2) to remain in force until water levels improves.
