

2. BUDGET PROCESS OVERVIEW

The draft medium Term Operating Budget for 2009/10 to 2011/2012 was tabled at the Council meeting held on the 31 March 2009, subsequent to the tabling of the budget the draft budget and proposed tariffs were publicized for stakeholders and public comments.
